- Nominated best touristic destination in Mexico by Food and Travel
- Second safest city in America.

TAHDZIU

- Considered the poorest municipality in Latin America
- 94.11% of its population is in extreme poverty.

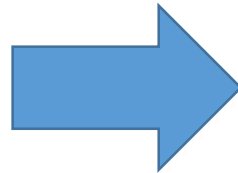

The started point is a logical framework matrix for each of the objectives

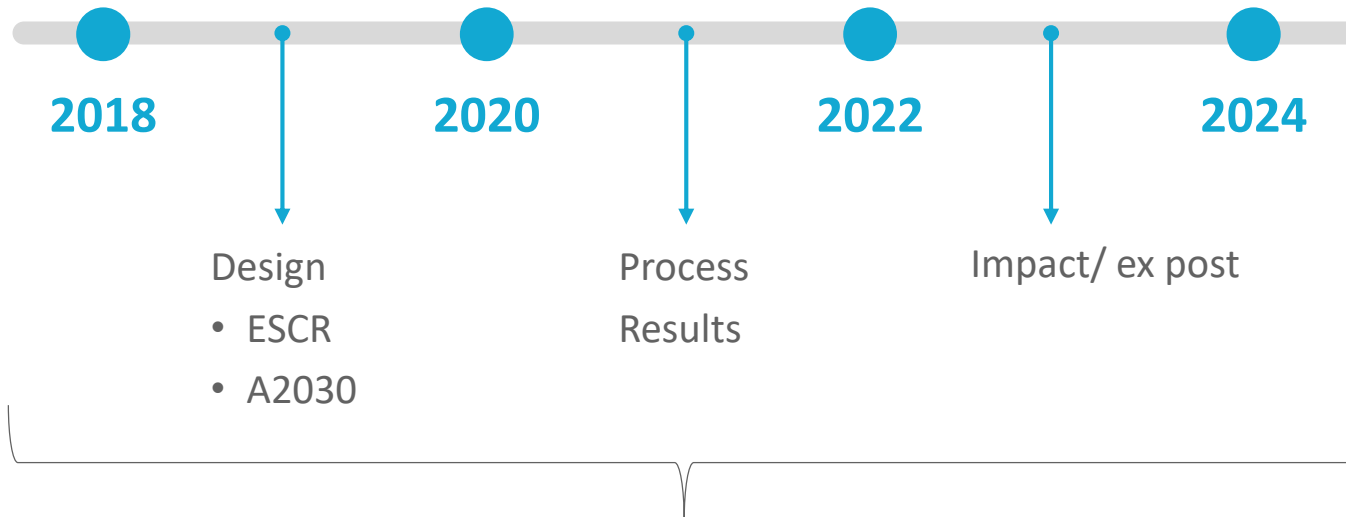

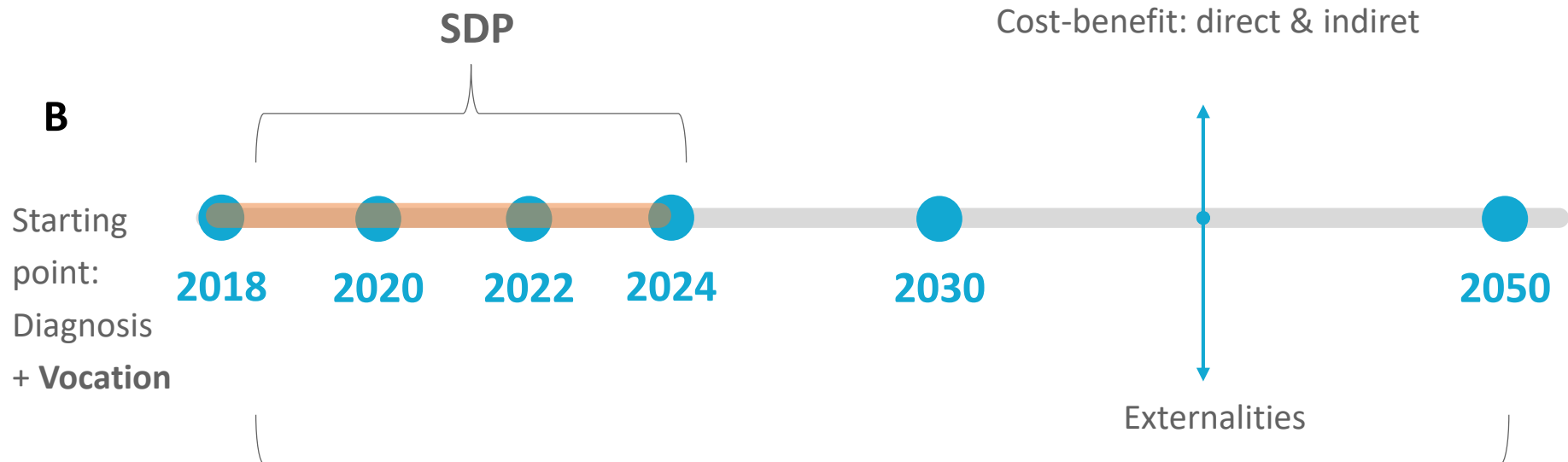

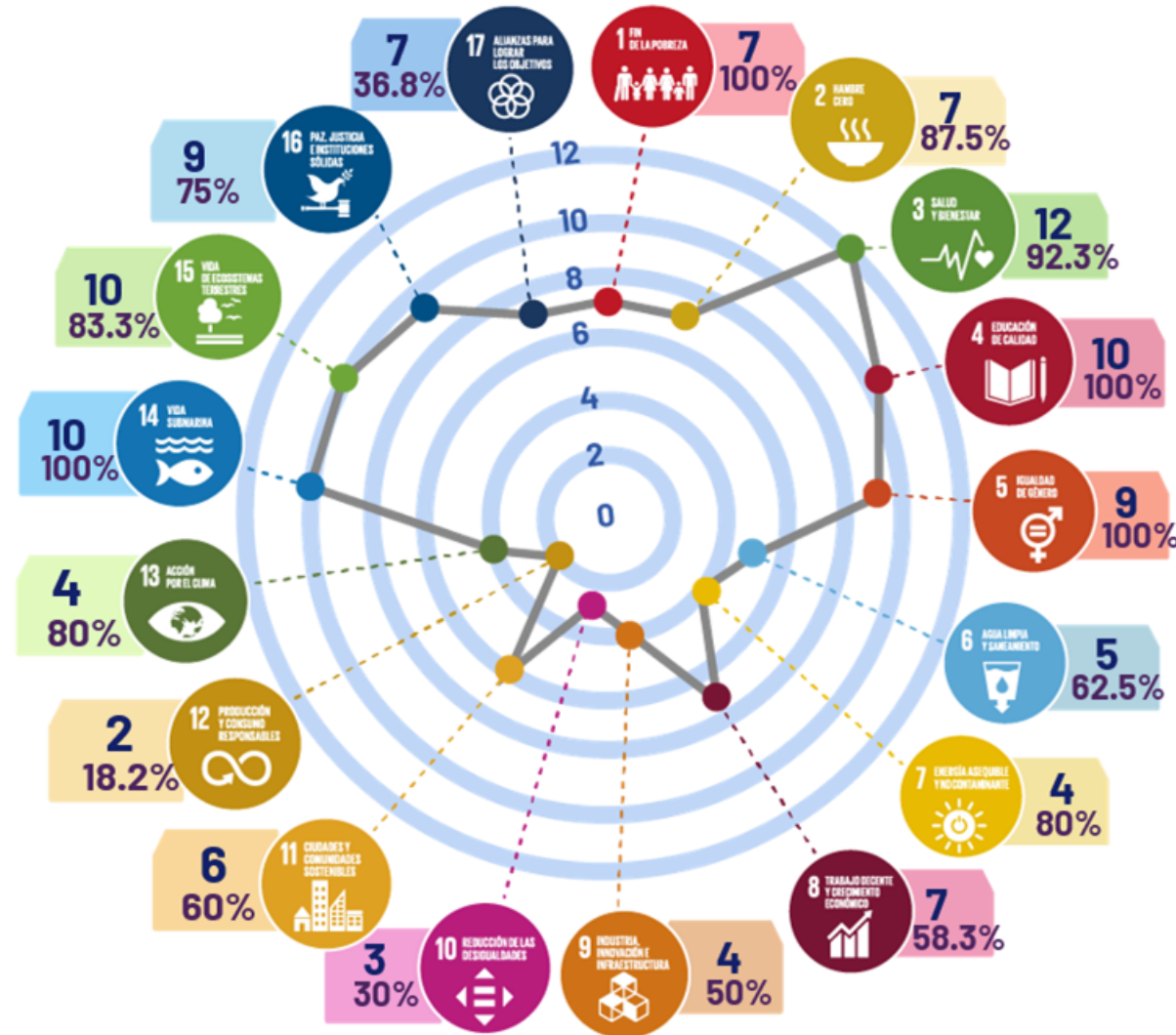

SDP 2018-2024

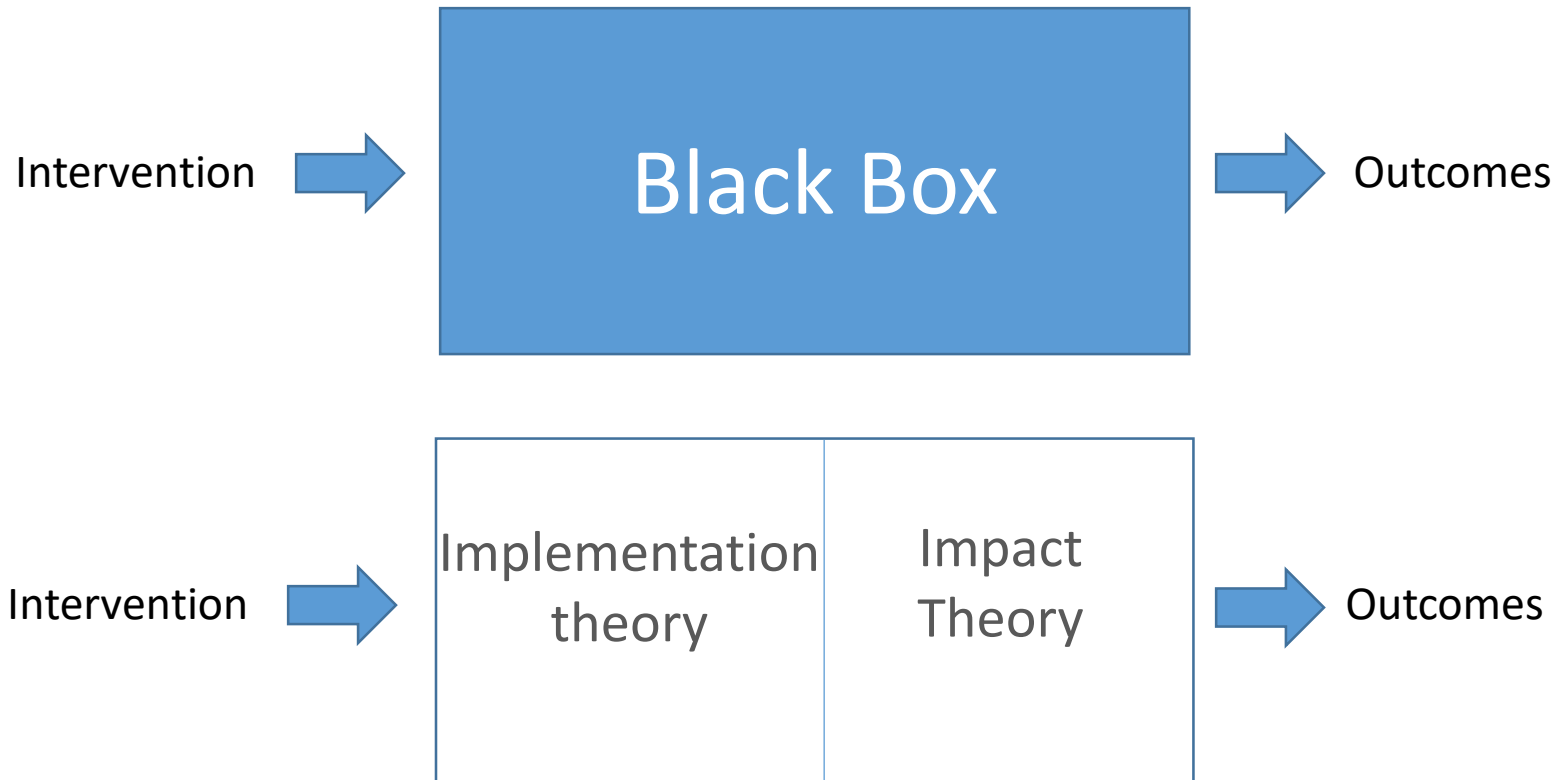
- **116 goals** have a direct impact on the SDP

- There is an **achievement** of more than **80%** in 9 of the 17 SDG



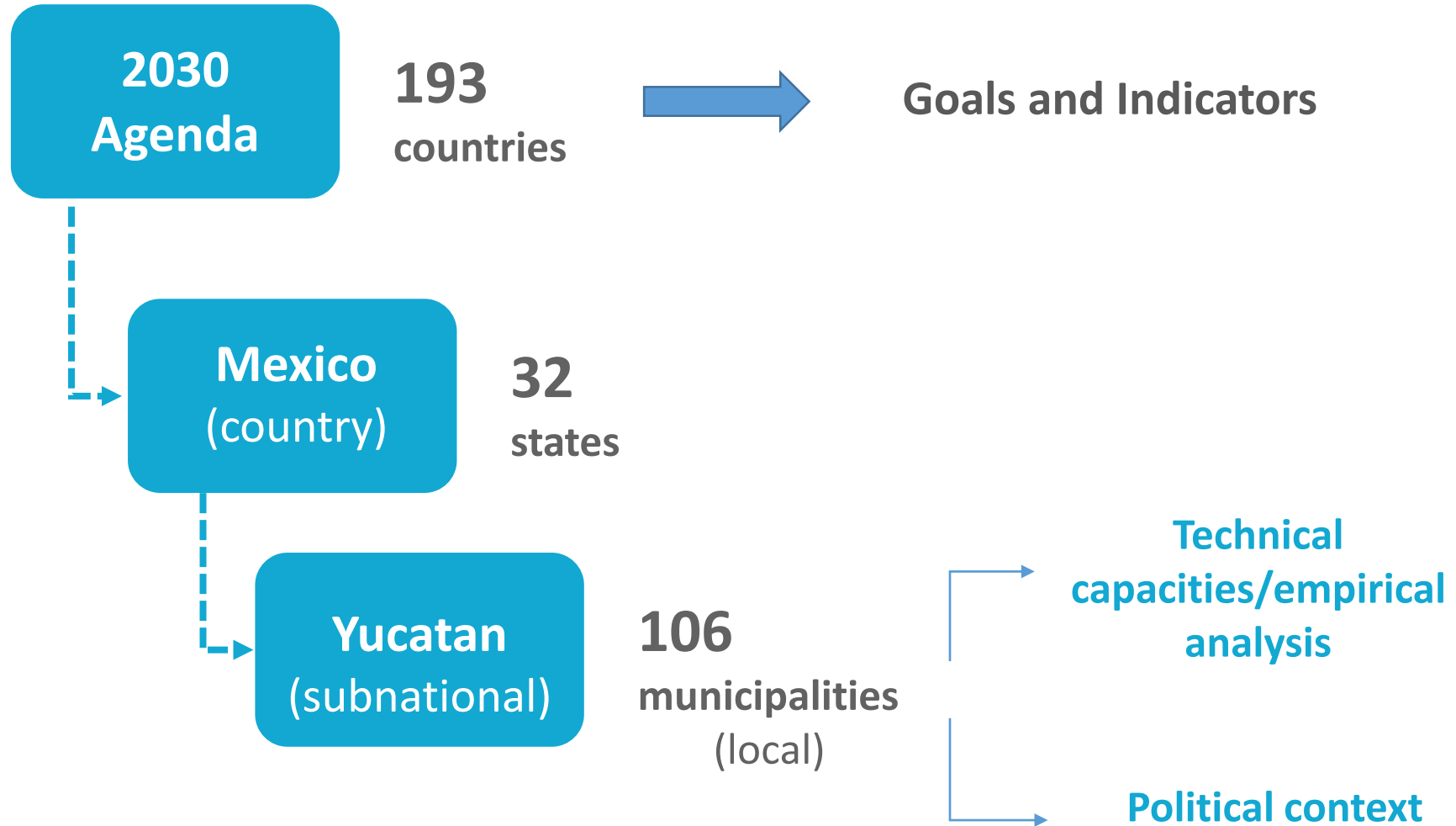

Theory failure vs Implementation failure



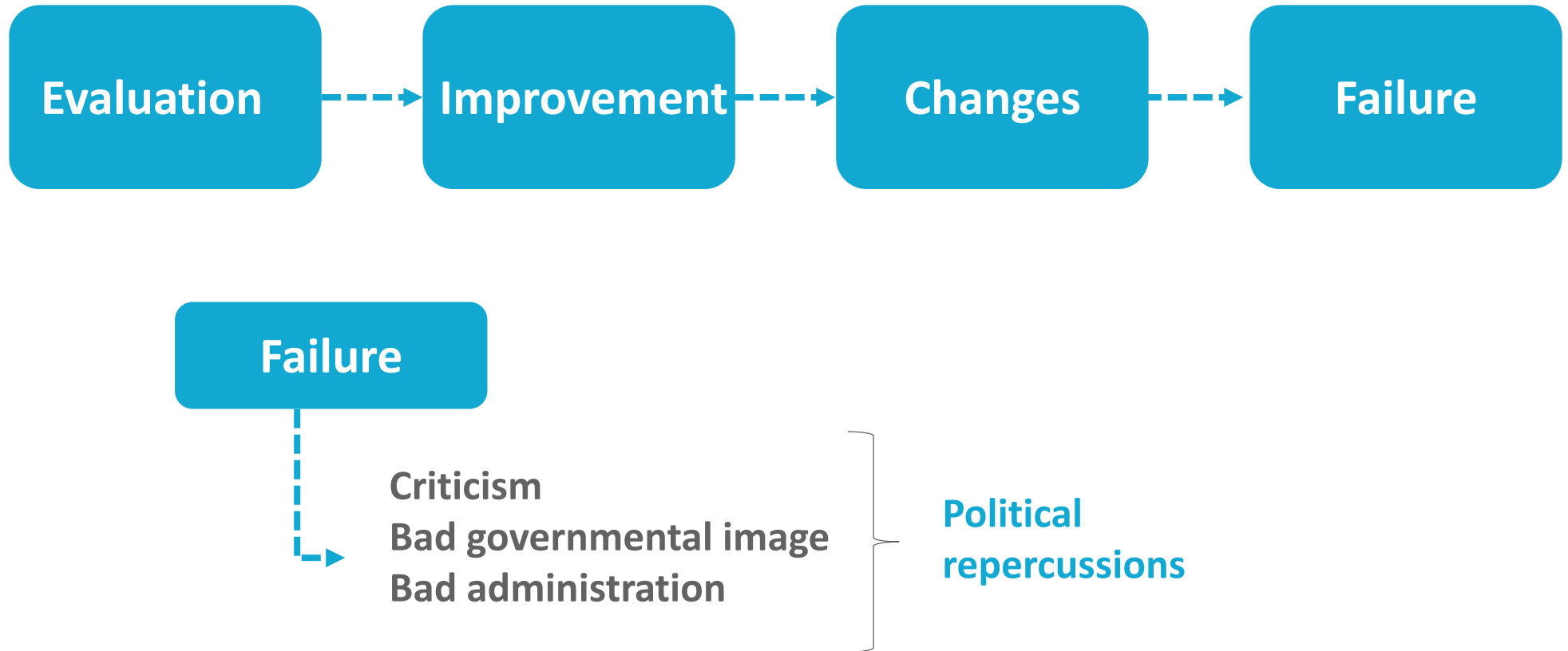

- Indicators 14.1.1
 - Index of coastal eutrophication and floating plastic debris density
- Target 14.1
 - By 2025, prevent and significantly reduce marine pollution of all kinds, in particular from land-based activities, including marine debris and nutrient pollution

- The answer to the question of how to evaluate the 2030 Agenda, is high quality administrative registries.
- Short term evaluation with long term vision (SDP-LTEP)
- Generating capacities and promoting the culture of evaluation (Young and emerging evaluators-Evalyouth)
- A Long Term Strategic Plan to avoid modifications in measures as a result of political changes.
- A complete 2030 Agenda strategy at local level. (CEA2030, VNL, etc.)
