# Liberia PAPD

## Pro-poor Agenda for Prosperity & Development (PAPD) is a 5-year Medium-term National Development Plan

- The PAPD adopted the Social Cohesion and Reconciliation (SCORE) Index as a high-level M&E tool for all of its pillars
- SCORE can be calibrated and tailored to each context, thus making it an appropriate and easily adaptable assessment instrument for M&E toolkits
- The last SCORE Liberia data was collected in Spring 2018, thus SCORE is not only well-suited for monitoring PAPD targets but establishes a valuable baseline for the PAPD
- **Data** presented here shows progress from SCORE 2016 related to peace and reconciliation compared to SCORE 2018 SCORE

# FOUR PAPD PILLARS:

**Pillar 1: 'Power to the People'** - empower Liberians gain control of lives reaching their furthest first and leaving no one behind

**Pillar 2: Economy and jobs** – creating a stable macro-economic environment, enabling private sector economic growth, greater competitiveness, and diversification of the economy

**Pillar 3: 'Sustaining the Peace'** – building stronger justice, peace and security institutions enable peaceful and safe environments

**Pillar 4: Governance and Transparency** – Inclusive and accountable public sector for shared prosperity and sustainable development

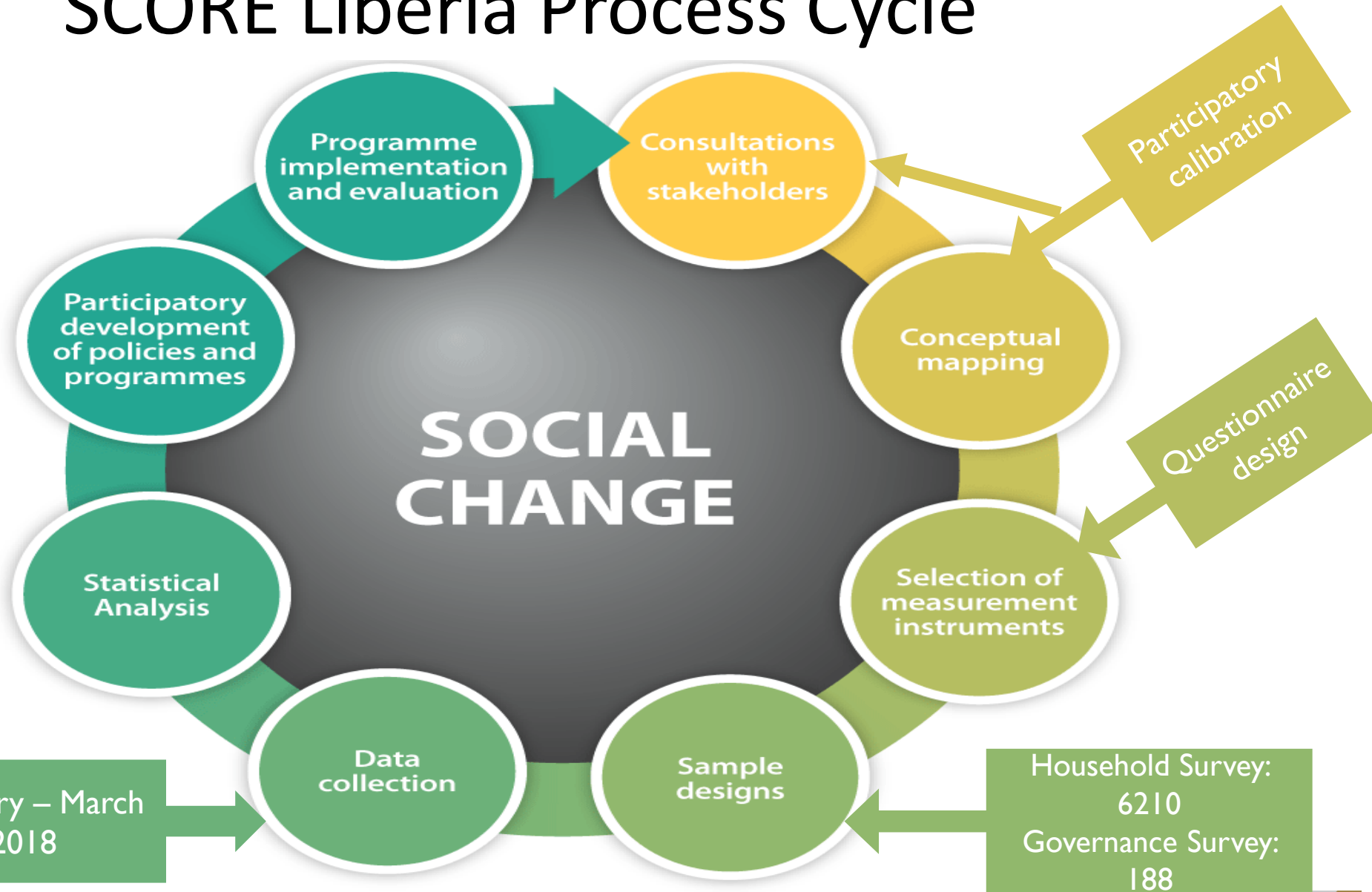
# Pillar 3: Sustaining the Peace

- The key outcomes aim to achieve positive peace through social cohesion and inclusive development
- Promote peace, justice and build strong institutions by:
  1. Addressing fragility and the root causes of conflict
  2. Improving the justice system and human rights protection, and
  3. Enhancing national defence and security
- To that end, PAPD sets long, medium, short term targets using SCORE indicators

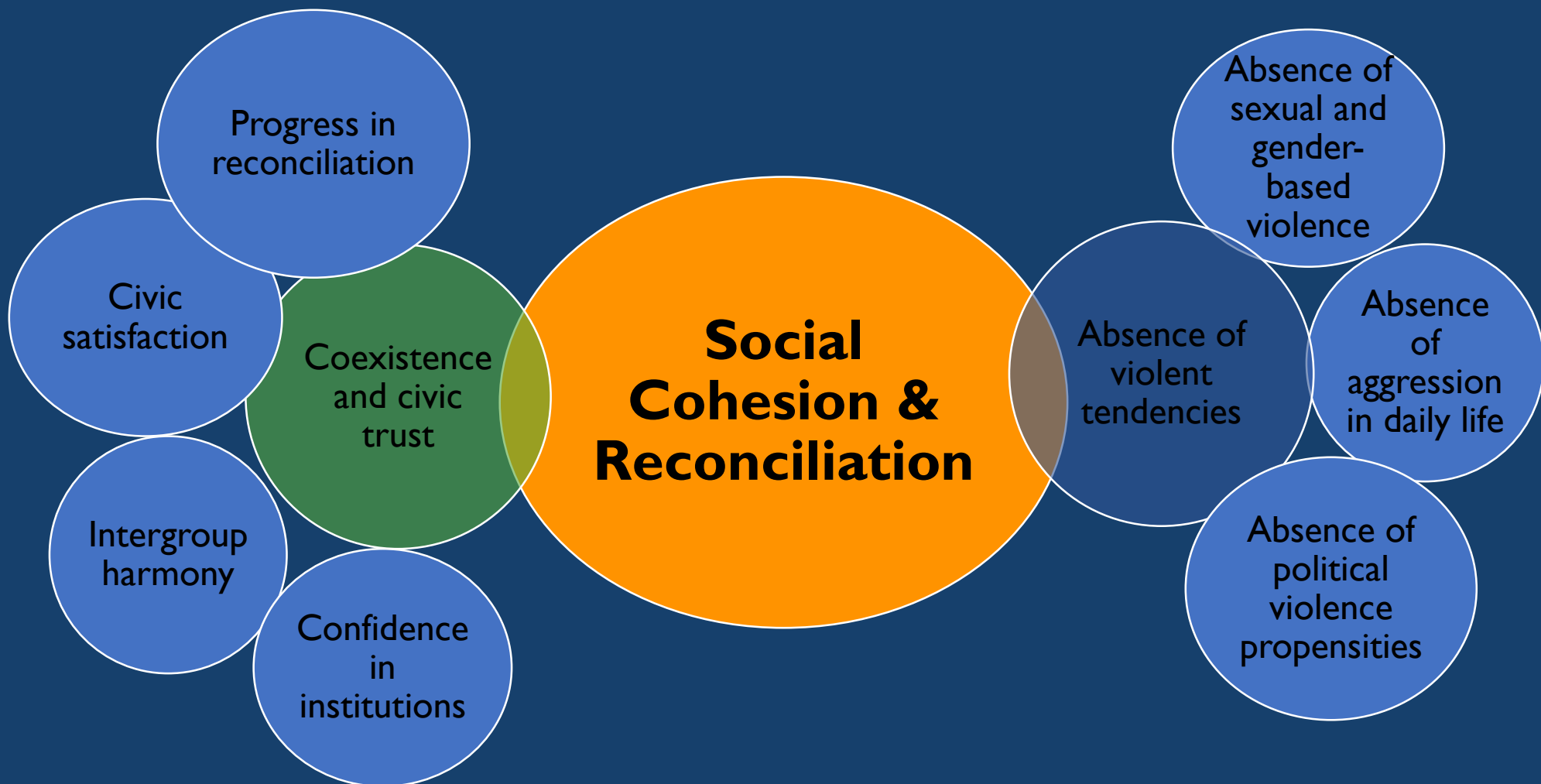
# SCORE Liberia Methodology

- M&E toolkits at all levels (policy, program, project) based on robust evidence even if they are about objective concrete outputs (e.g. infrastructure)
- A scientific and participatory approach to M&E is especially crucial, if they are about peacebuilding, social cohesion, inter-group relations and civic attitudes

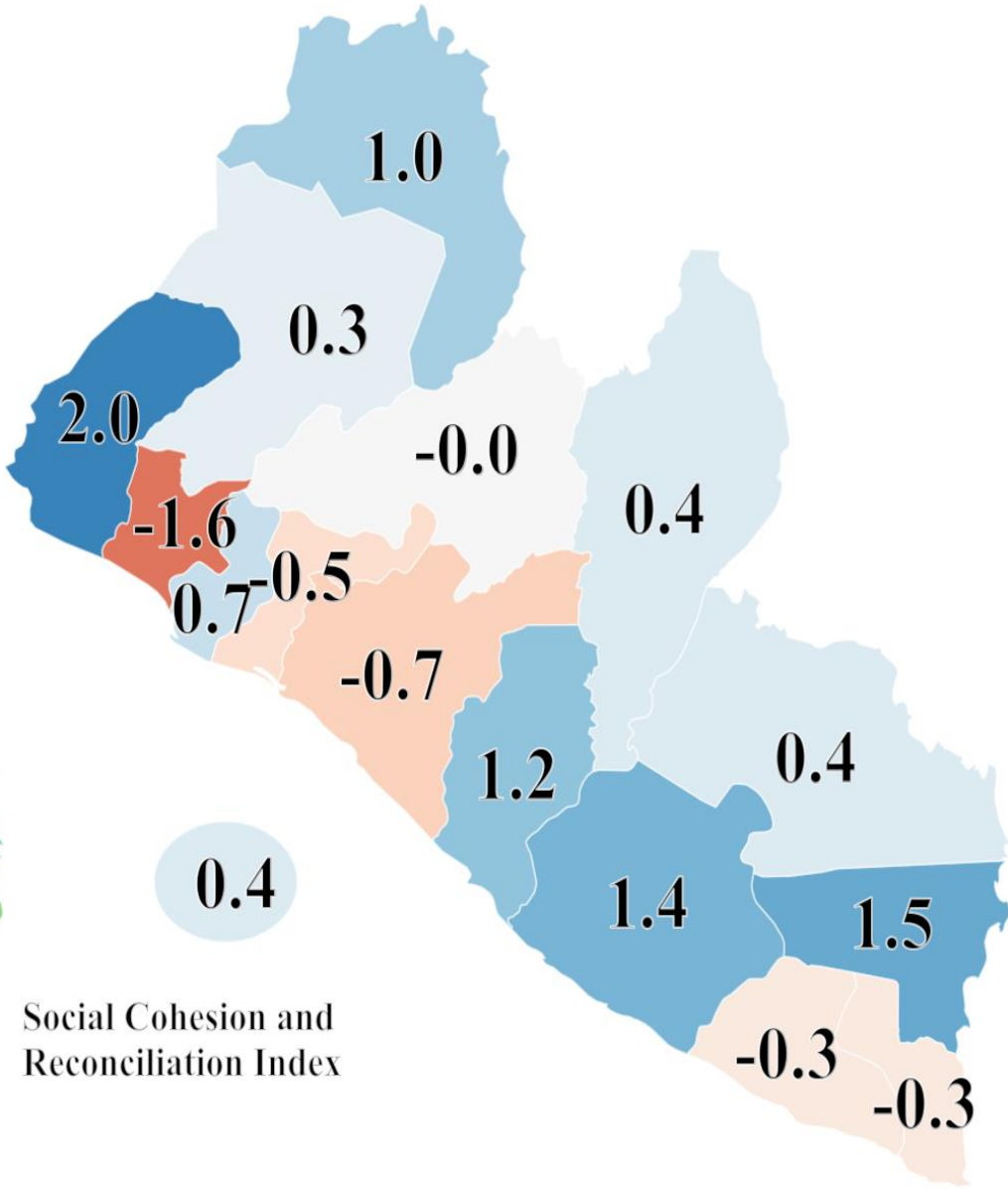
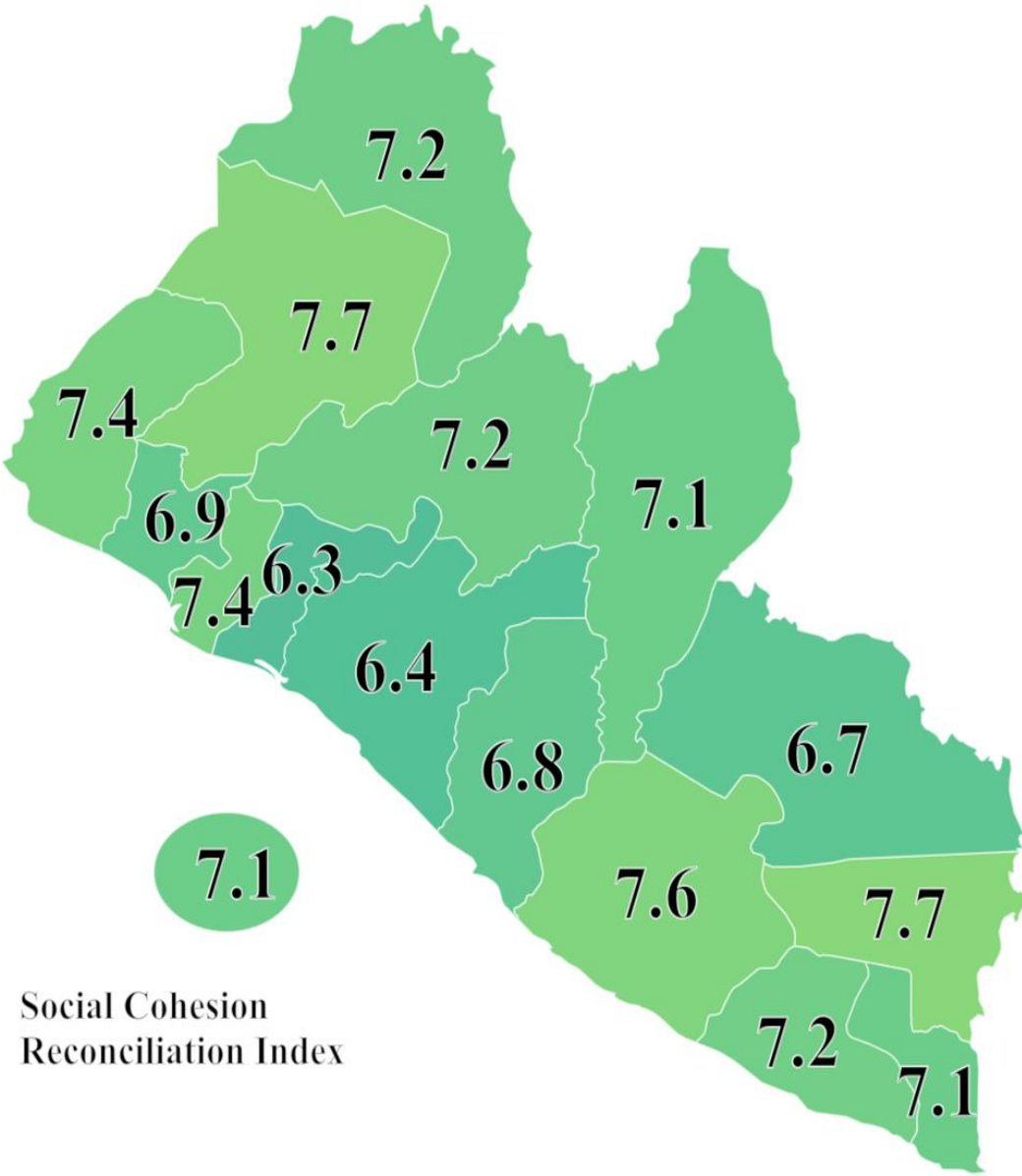
# SCORE Liberia Process Cycle



# PAPD High-Level Target 1: Overall SCORE Index Improves



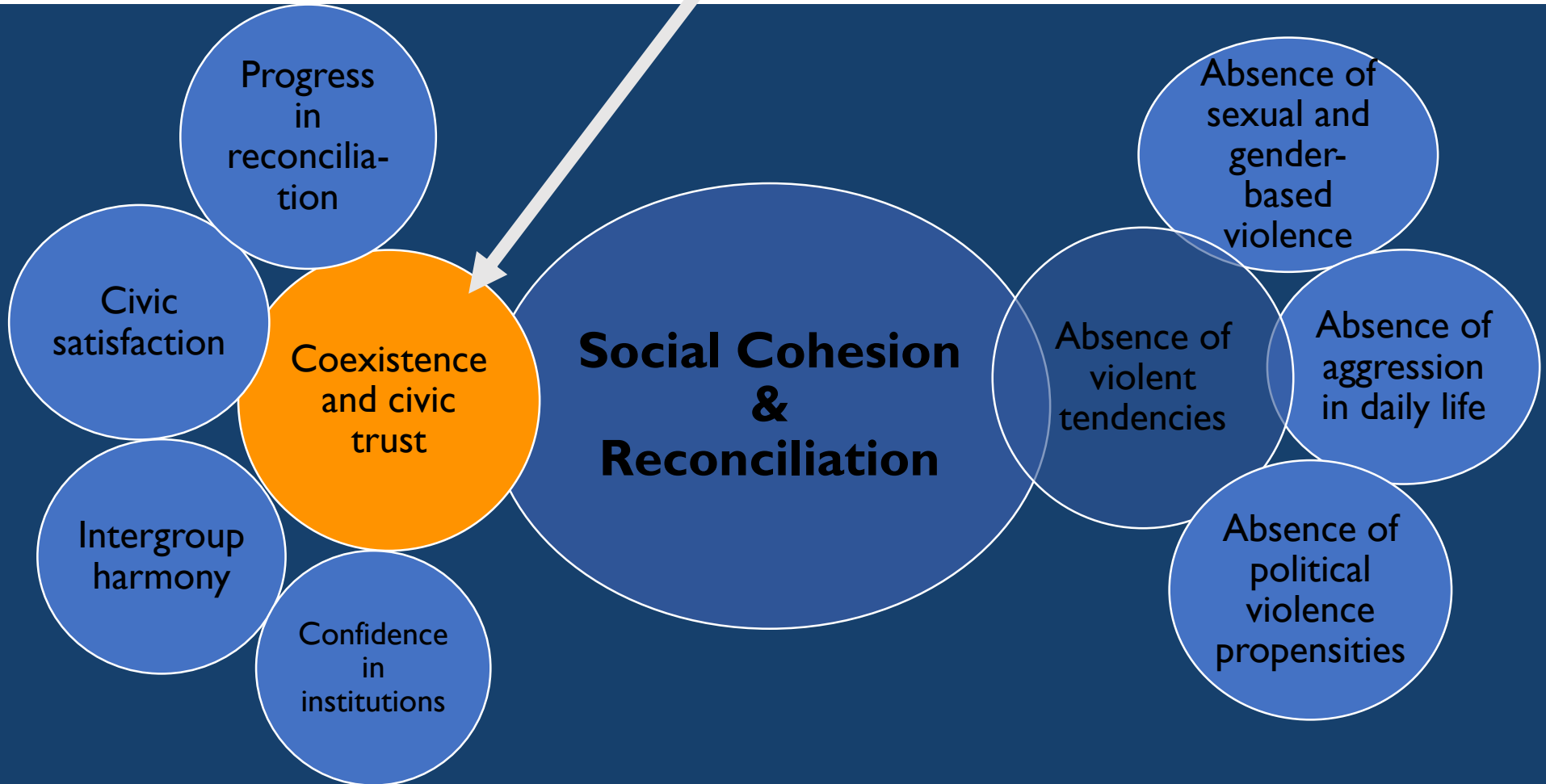


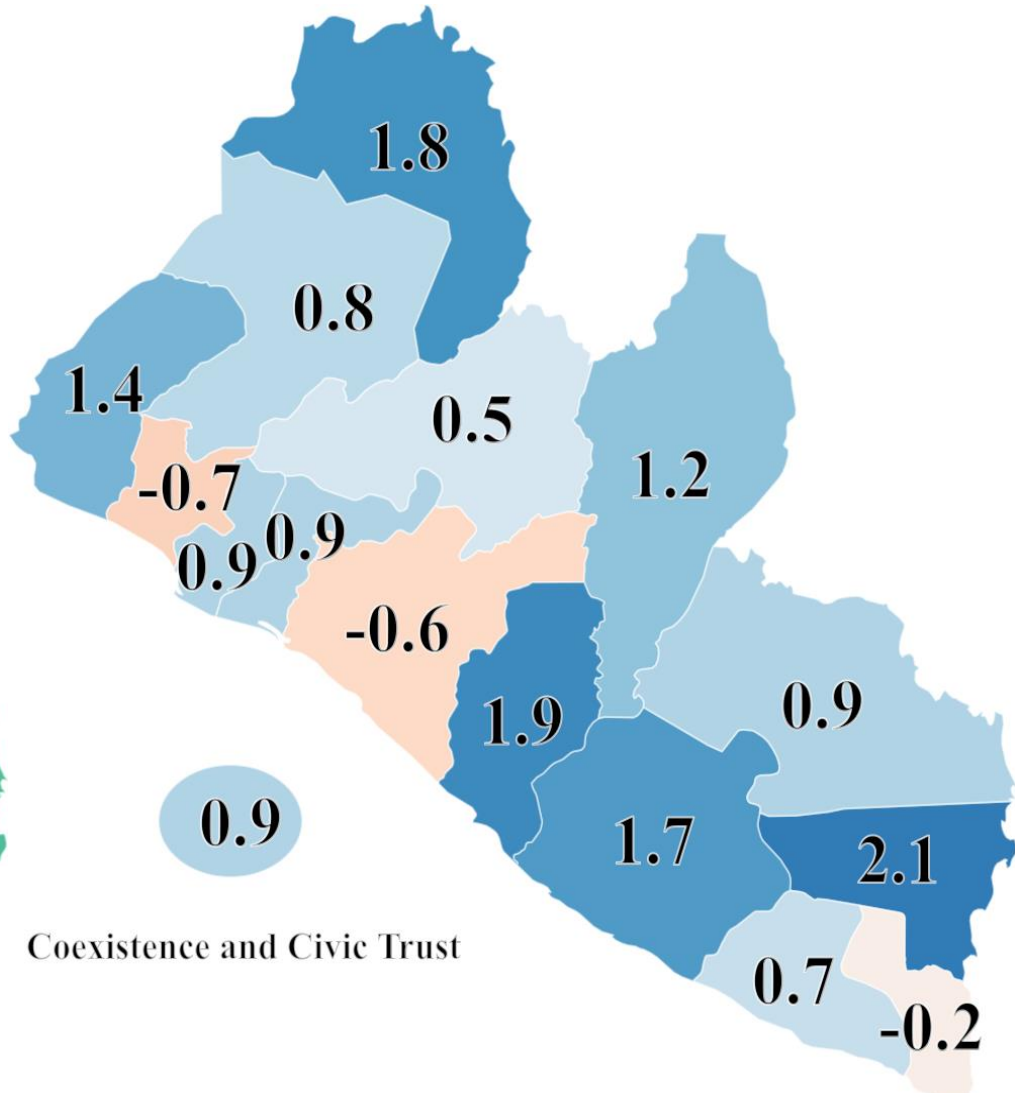
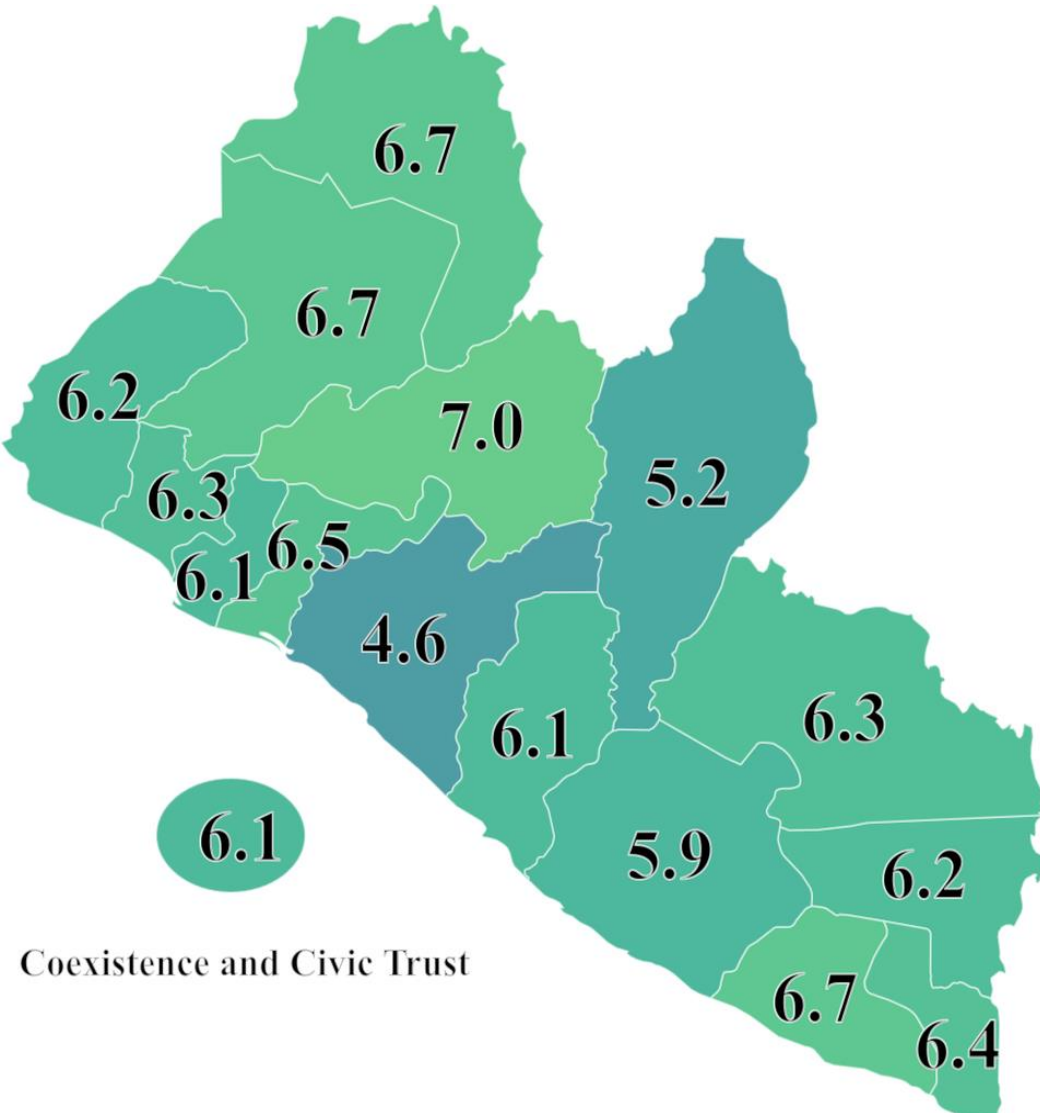




# PAPD High-Level Target 2:

## Civic trust and coexistence improves (disaggregated by county, gender)

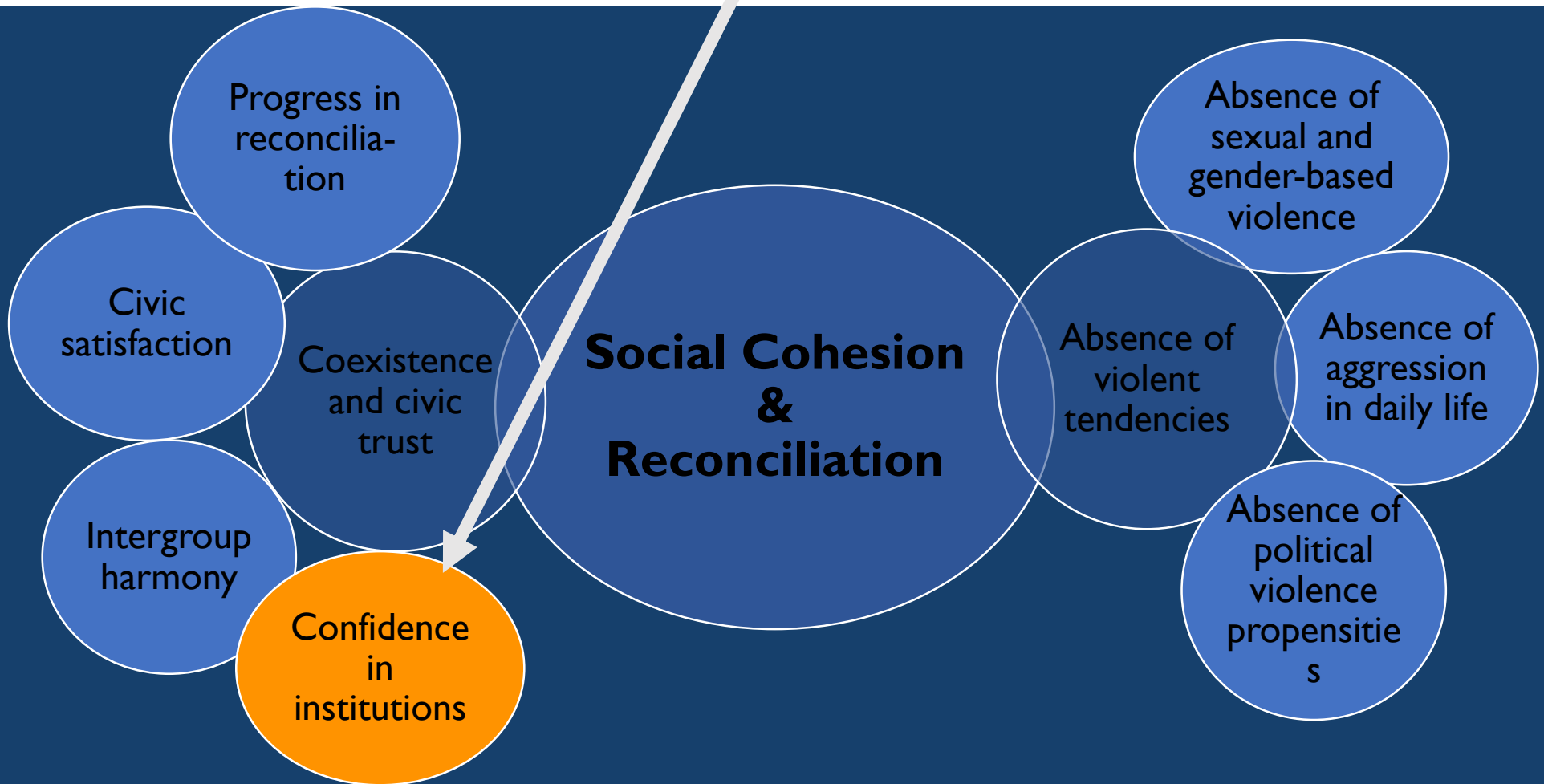


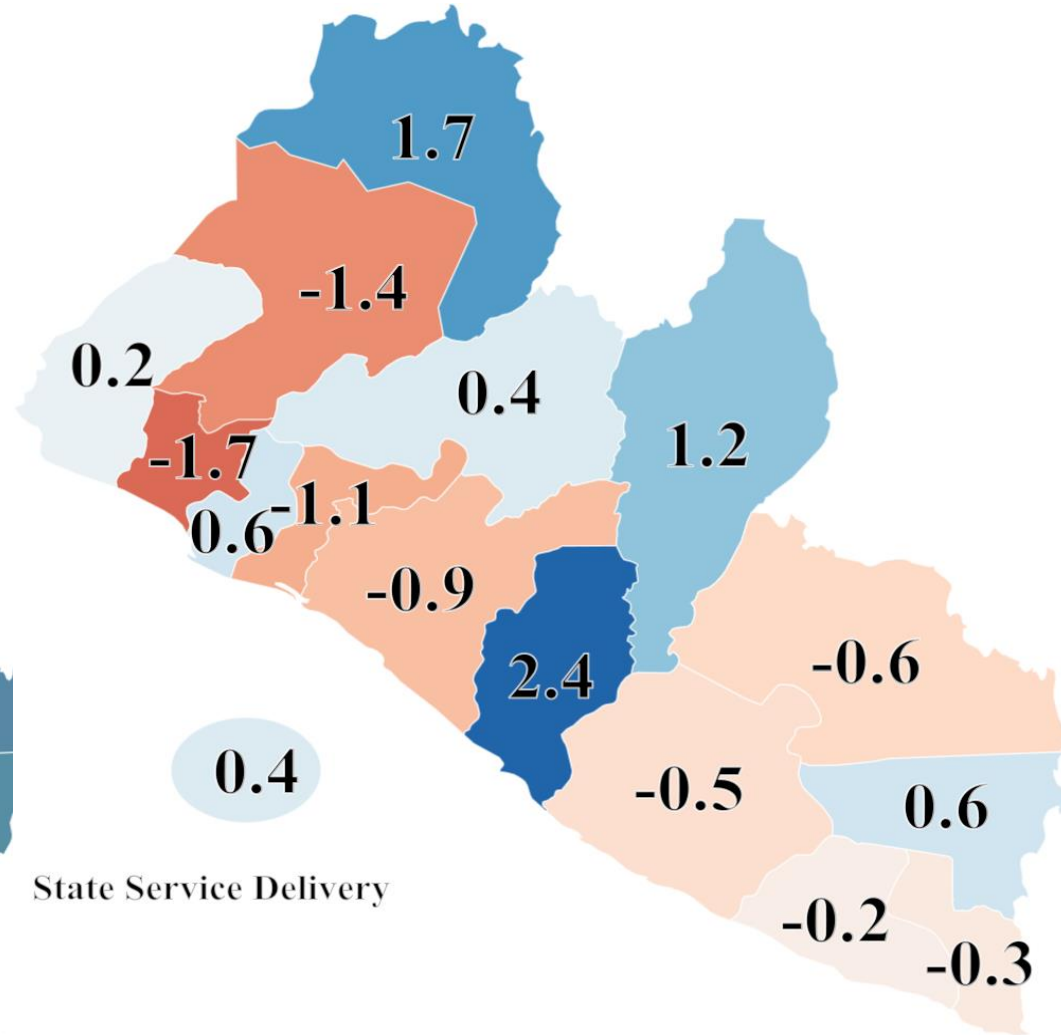
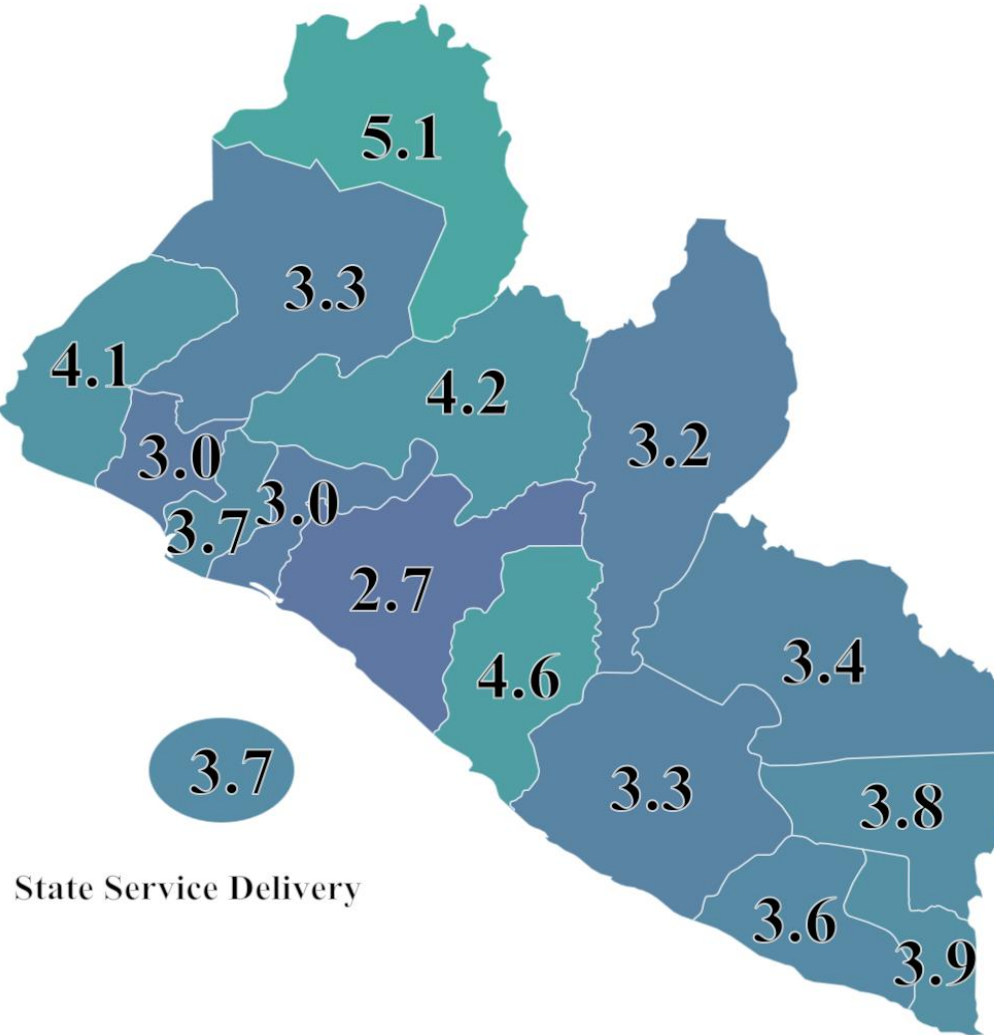


PAPD High-Level Target 2. Civic trust & coexistence improve: **5.2 > 7.7** (disaggregated by county/gender)

Satisfaction with state service delivery increase (disaggregated by county/gender)

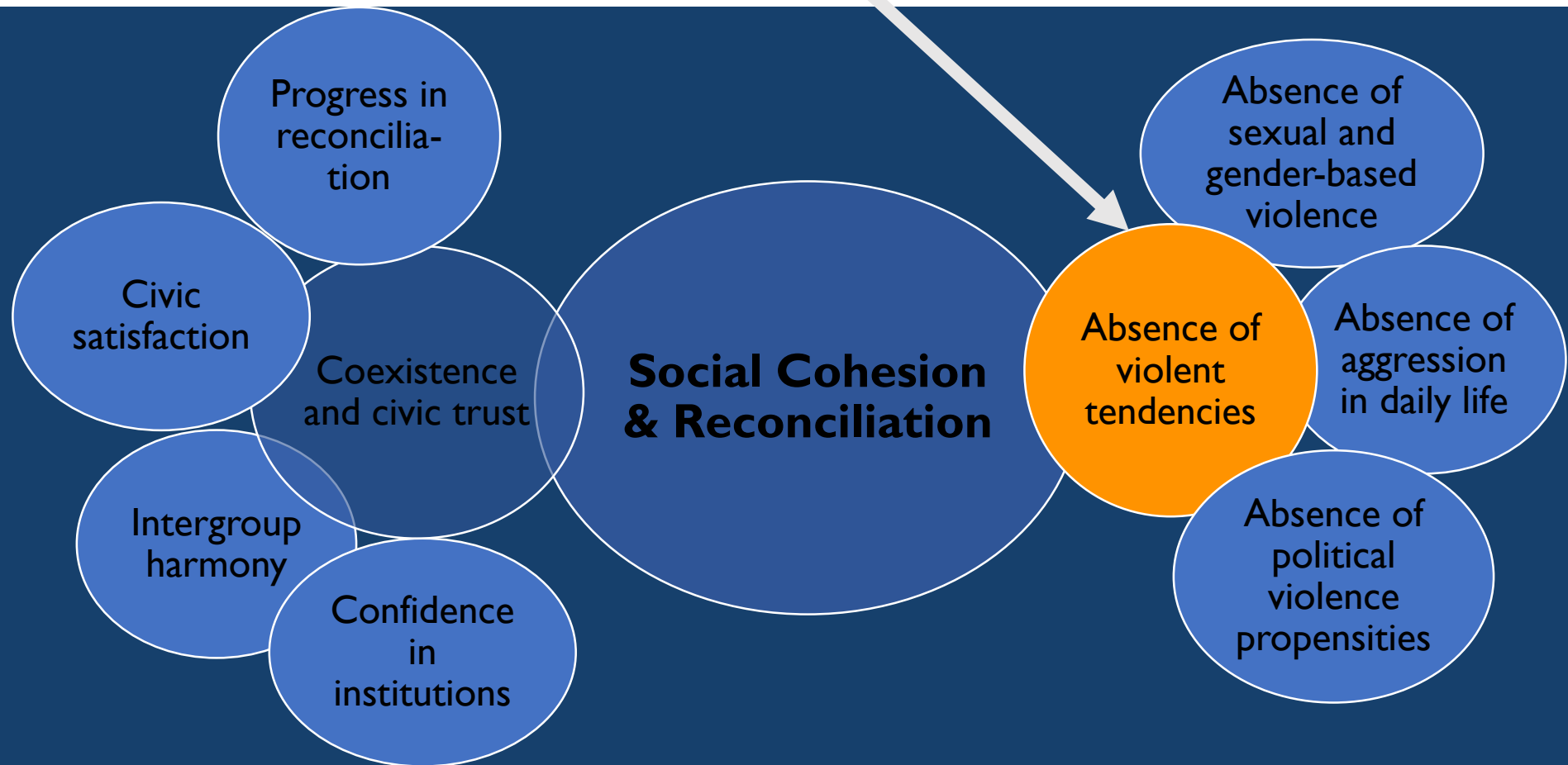




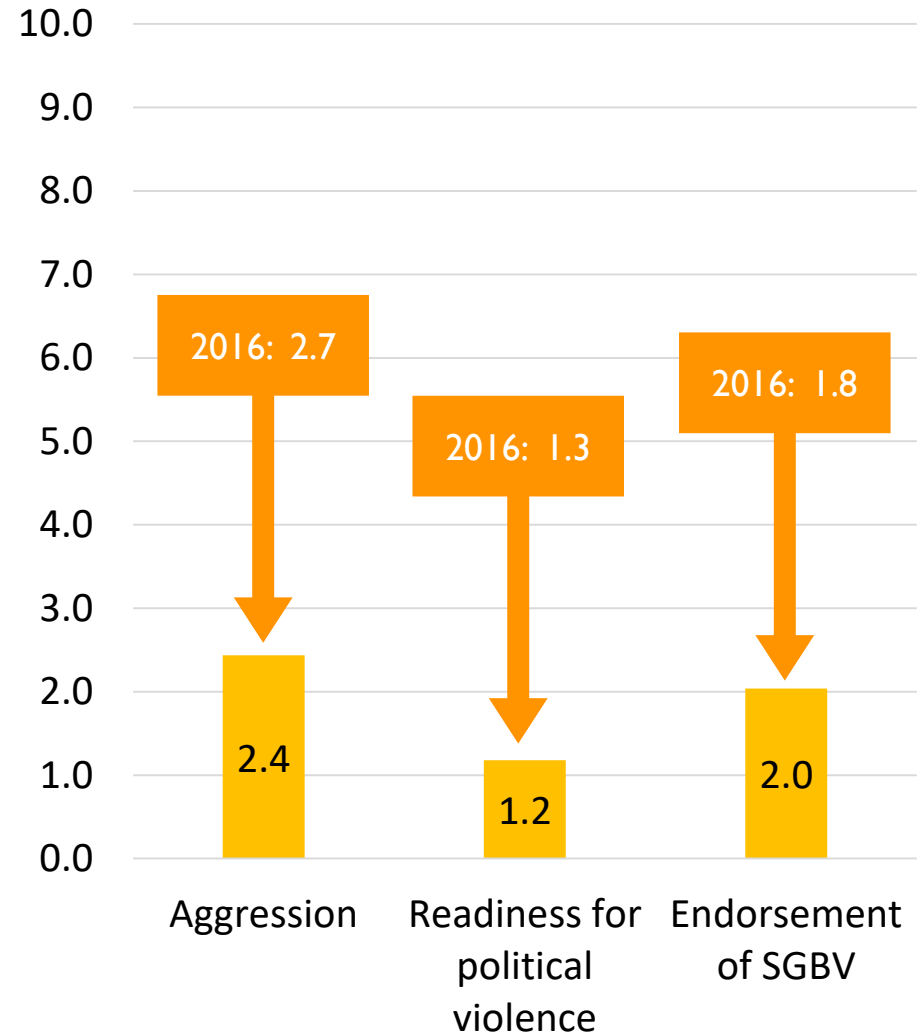
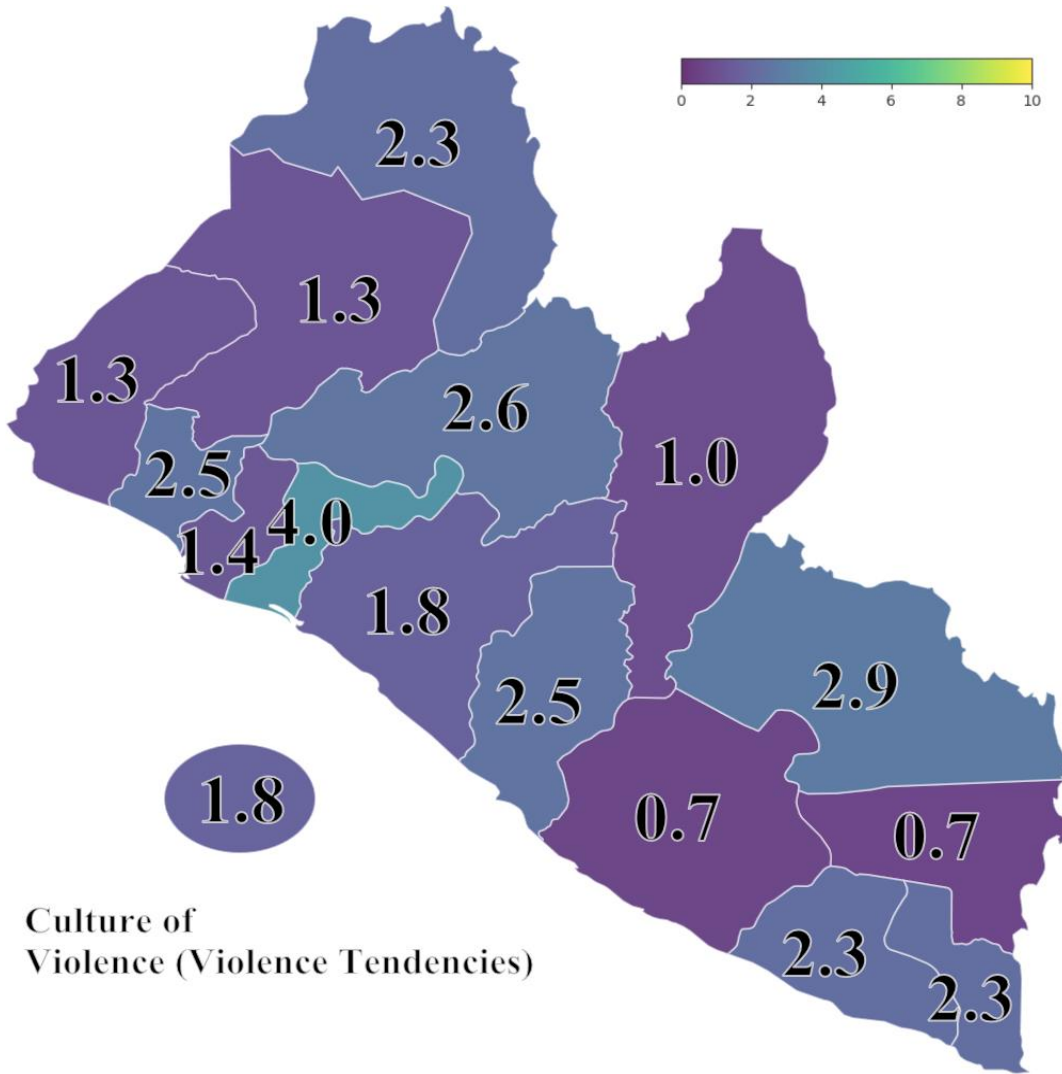
PAPD High-Level Target 3. Satisfaction with state service delivery increase:  $3.5 > 6.7$  (disaggregated by county, gender)

## Violence Tendencies



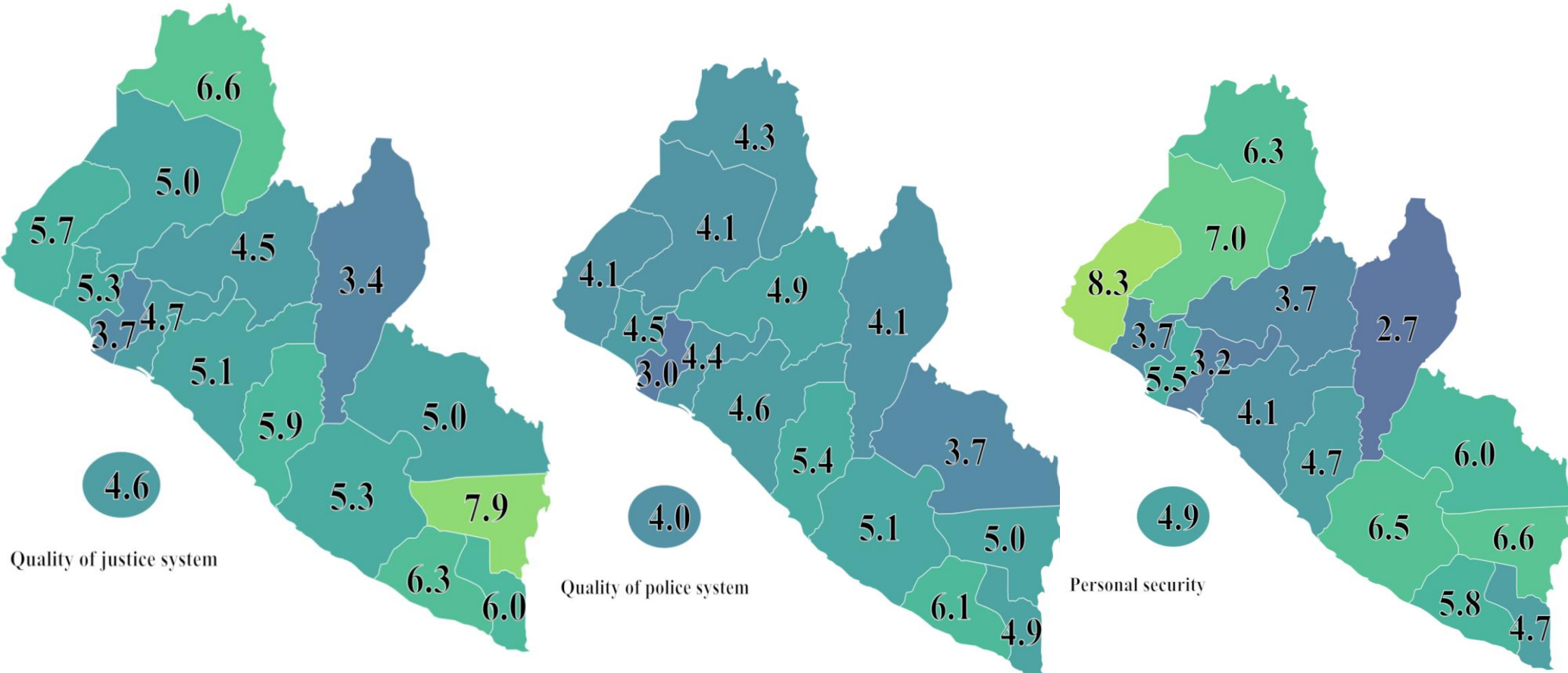
Culture of Violence (Violence Tendencies)

# Other PAPD High-Level Targets of Pillar 3:

Improvement of rule of law and justice system, including the level of safety citizens feel in their daily life and their belief that the police can protect them





# Key Messages:

- SCORE is a versatile and innovative research instrument for M&E of the SDGs, especially the SDG 16 through Multi-Agency and Multiple-stakeholders collaboration;
- SCORE draws inspiration from multiple scientific disciplines, it is flexible enough to incorporate on the ground-realities of each local and regional context;
- SCORE utilizes advanced analytic and participatory processes to guide evidenced-based policy and program design; and
- Findings can be used to optimize resource allocation by, designing and deploying well-targeted interventions that hold the greatest potential for violent prevention and conflict transformation
