

KAZAKHSTAN RANKED 35<sup>TH</sup> IN 2017 AGAINST 59<sup>TH</sup> IN 2011 IN DOING BUSINESS REPORT Interrelation between targets and budget programs was for the first time indicated in state bodies' strategic plans in 2016 specifying resources and result indicators.

Kazakhstan ranked 57<sup>th</sup> in 2017 against 72<sup>nd</sup> in 2011 in the GCI (Global Competitiveness Index)

3 times reduction in the share of investment projects due to initial design and estimate cost increase (6,5% in 2015 against 21,9% in 2012).

Internal control units were created in every state body with focus on preventive measure
