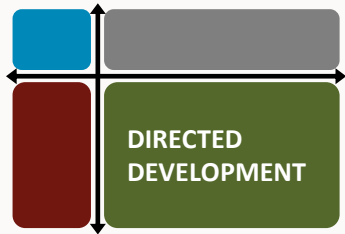

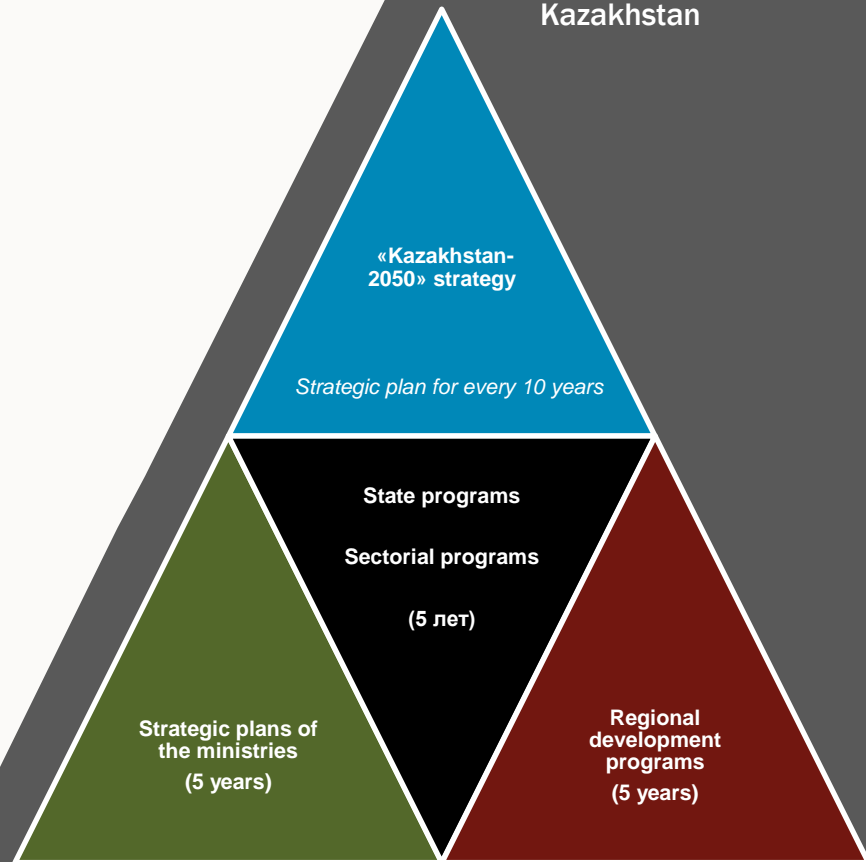
Hierarchy of strategic planning in Kazakhstan

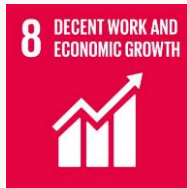

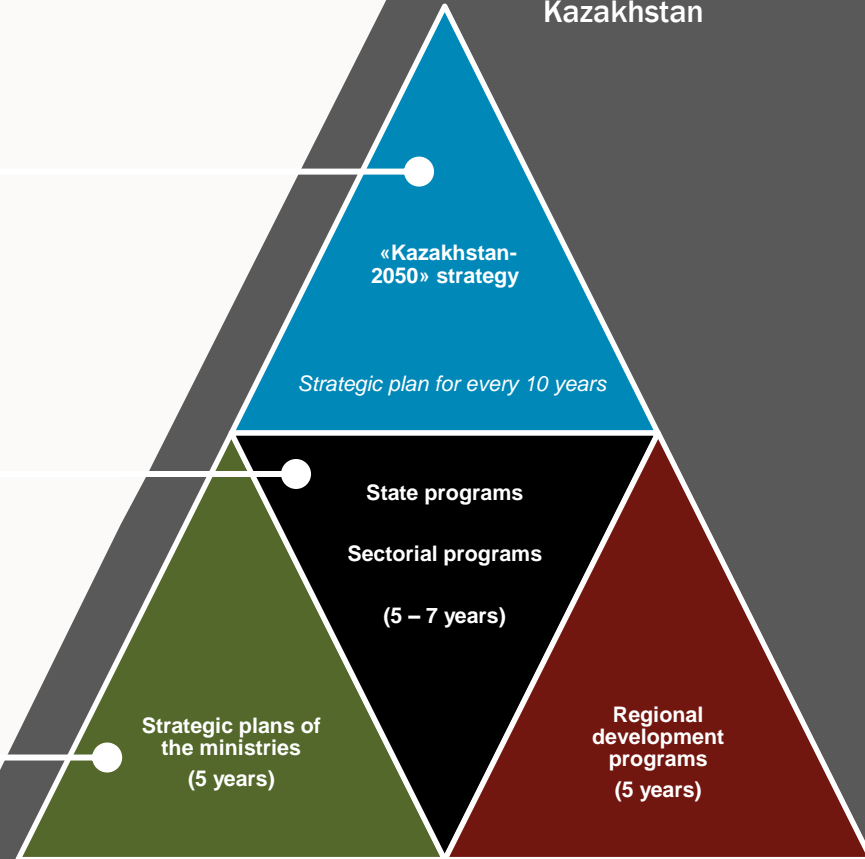

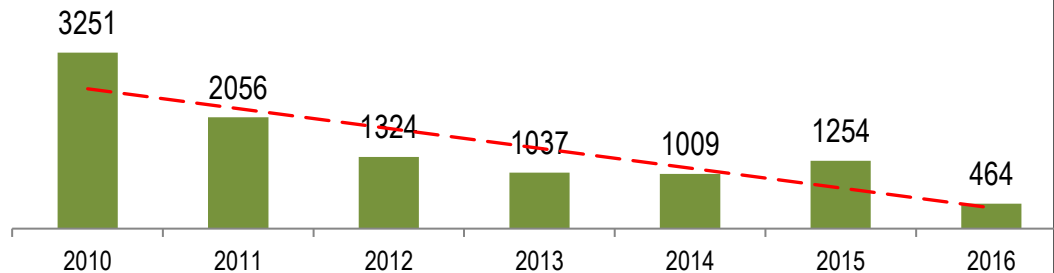


Underexpenditure

and budget programs was for

in 2016 specifying resources
and result indicators.

Kazakhstan ranked
57th in 2017 against
72nd in 2011 in the
GCI (Global
Competitiveness
Index)

3 times reduction in the share of
investment projects due to initial design
and estimate cost increase (6,5% in 2015
against 21,9% in 2012).

Internal control units were created in
every state body with focus on
preventive measure

The core list of
82 indicators
was formed to monitor
the performance of the
local authorities
