

1. Approaches for China's Implementation of the 2030 Agenda

Oversight and evaluation

- Conduct reviews of its implementation efforts simultaneously with annual assessment of the progress in the 13th Five-Year Plan.
- Participate in follow-up reviews at the international and regional levels.
- Strengthen cooperation with the United Nations System in China and other international organizations.



Insufficient capacity of Chinese evaluation community in terms of:

- Understanding to 2030 Agenda and SDGs,
- The number of qualified evaluation organizations and professional evaluators,
- > Evaluation tools and instruments.

The way forward:

- Capacity building
- Sharing of international best practice



lack of a comprehensive data collection system:

- Many SDGs' indicators are not in the existing statistical system,
- > High cost and low timeliness of data collection.

The way forward:

- Make full use of ICT tools
- > Develop infrastructure of big data analysis



quantitative evaluation:

> Are all the SDGs goals and indicators SMART?

> 50% not.

The way forward:

Rely on countries to develop specific quantitative indicators which is reflecting country's context as well as accepted by common international standards.
