




IMPLEMENTATION COORDINATION MACHINERY







OBJECTIVES OF OUTCOME BASED MONITORING


To evaluate the effectiveness of programs/projects to the target group



THE SHORTCOMINGS OF 9th MALAYSIA PLAN APPROACH

The present monitoring system was mainly focused on implementation and monitoring of physical projects (output oriented rather than outcomes based). There were no explicit linkages between implementation levels and the higher level outcomes at the sectoral as well as national level.

The focus was more on projects rather than on programs.





Integrated Performance Framework:




