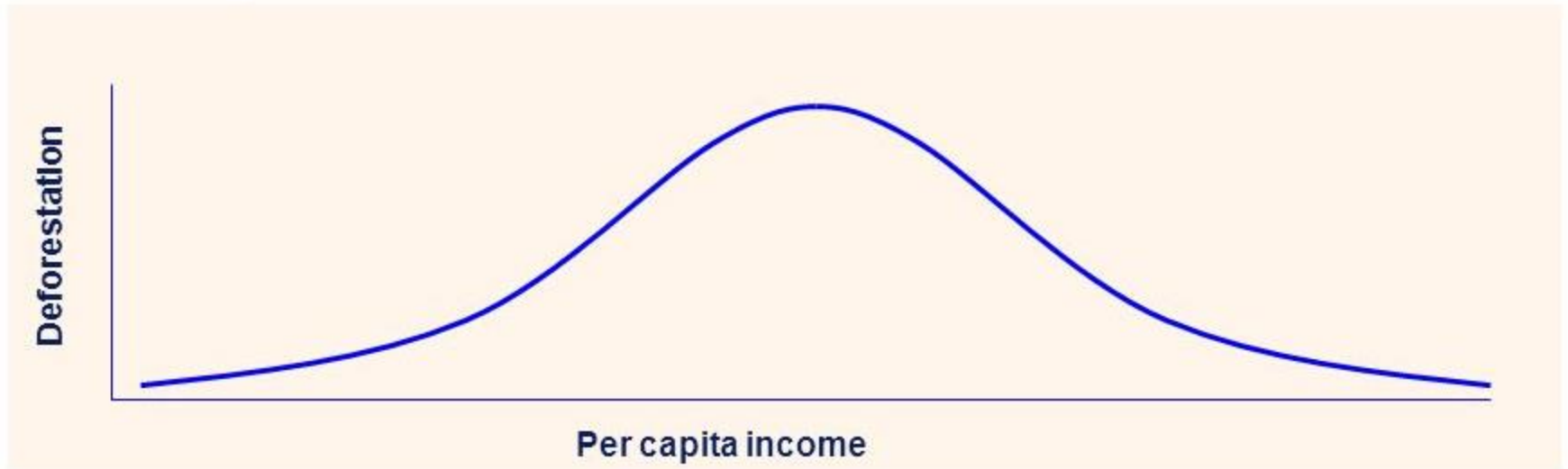

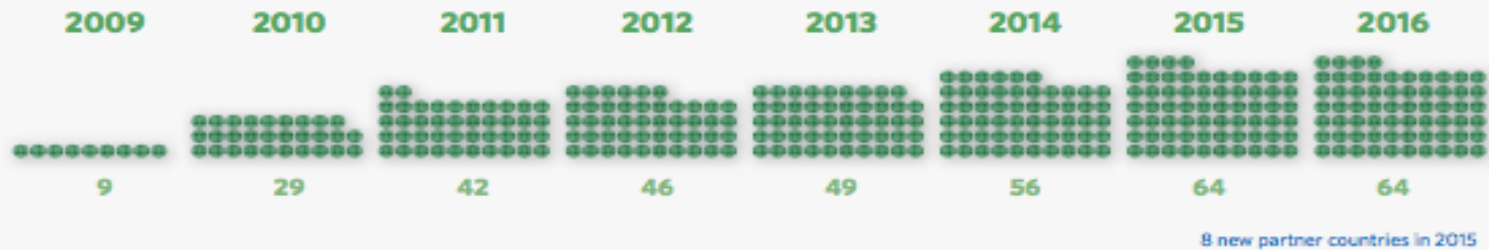

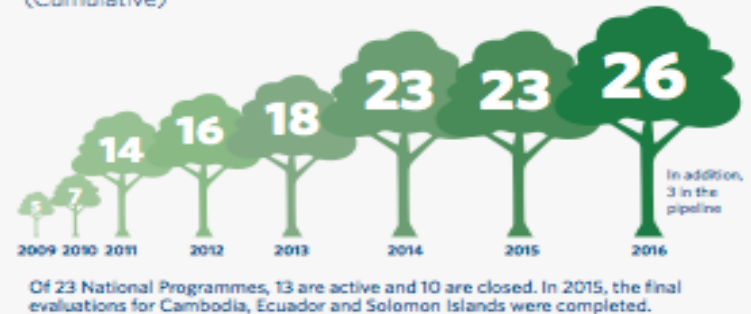
## Number of Partner Countries

## Number of countries that have received backstopping



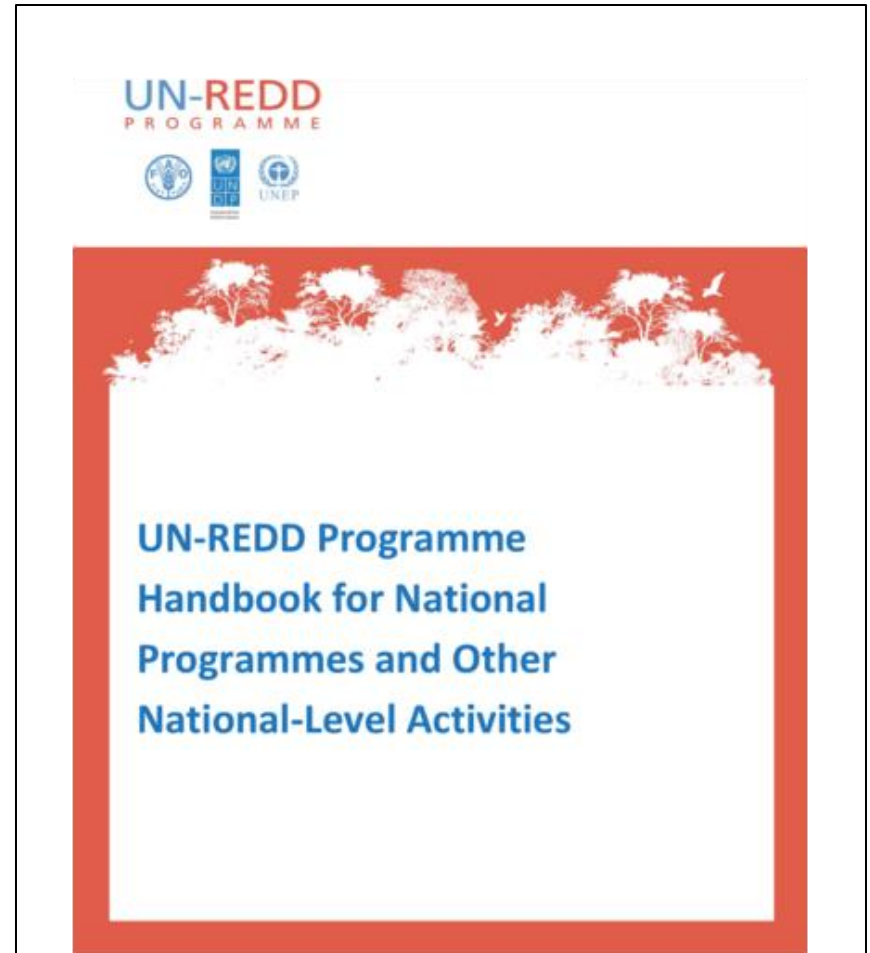
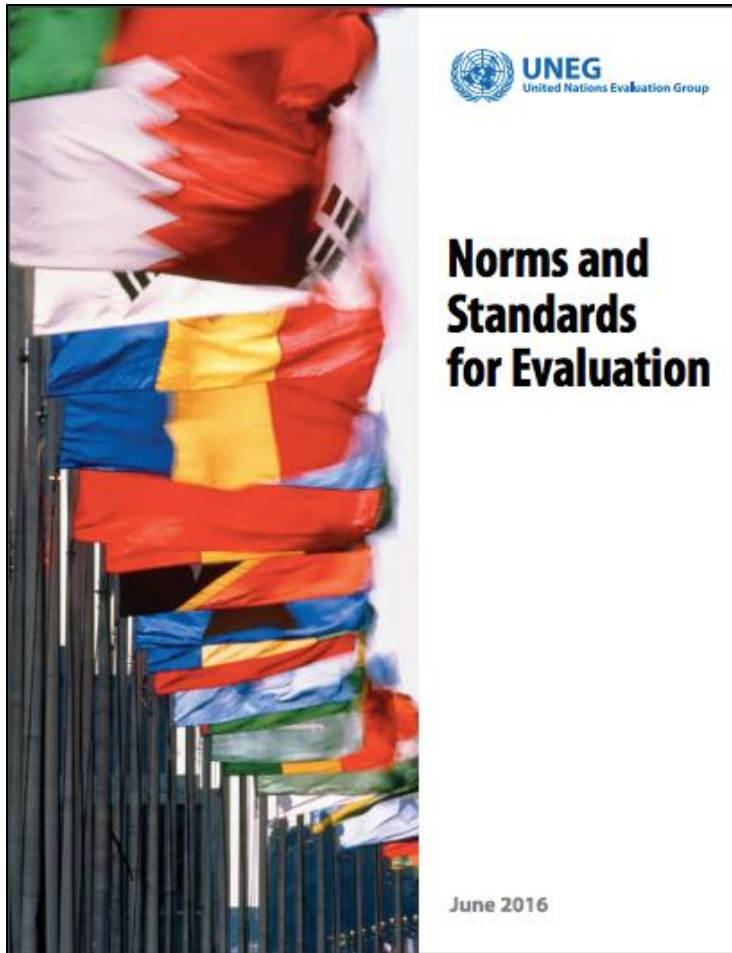

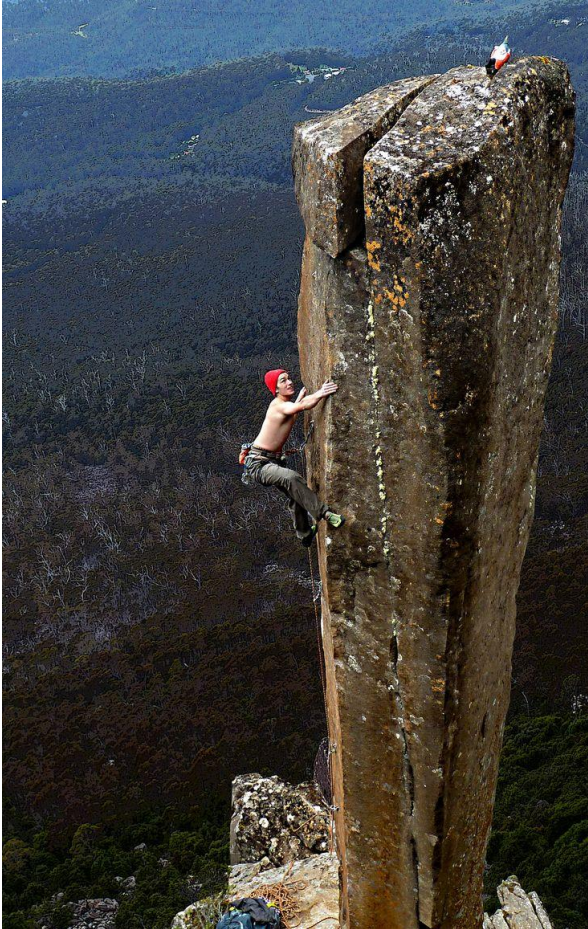

# Concerns

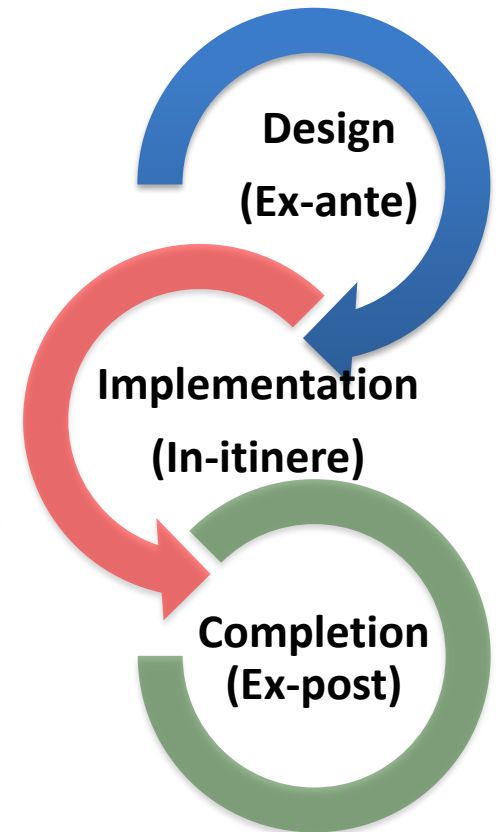
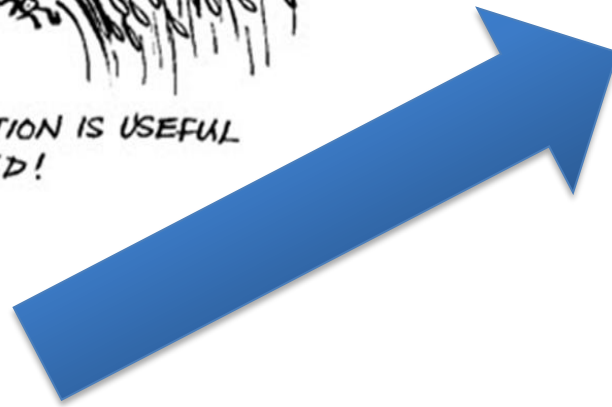
- Cost effectiveness and transactions
